BACKGROUND

The Council has a legal duty to ensure that every child resident in the Borough has a school place. The increasing demand for primary school places in this area, Worcester's Primary School has recently completed building works so that it can accommodate 630 pupils plus 30 Nursery places and the continued use of the Children Centre.

The volume of pedestrian and vehicle traffic has increased as a result of this expansion and recent surveys highlight the risk of conflicts at the junction of Goat Lane and Garnault Road.

CURRENT PROPOSALS

Based on our observations and as part of the council's policy on promoting sustainable travel the Council proposes the following measures, illustrated on the inside of this leaflet:

- **Goat Lane by Garnault Road Junction Improvements** - Kerb realignment and upgrade of the existing speed table/raised junction. This should provide improved storage and safety for pedestrians crossing the junction and additional speed management;

In addition,

- **Raised Zebra Crossing in Goat Lane east of the school entrance** - To give priority to pedestrians over the increasing traffic flow at the junction.
